

GOLF CART BYLAW

BYLAW 6/01

A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE THE USE OF GOLF CARTS ON VARIOUS STREETS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF CANWOOD.

Council of the Village of Canwood in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. It shall be lawful to operate a Golf Cart during the hours between one-half hour before sunrise and one-half hour after sunset on all public highways within the boundaries of the Village of Canwood, with the exception of Main Street and those portions of Provencal Highway No.55 within the Village. Notwithstanding the forgoing, Golf Carts will be permitted to cross Main Street.
2. Drivers must have a valid drivers' licence.
3. Notwithstanding Clause 2. residents without a drivers' licence, who are at least 16 years of age, will be permitted to operate a golf cart, if a recommendation from a physician is provided and the Council of the Village of Canwood specifically approves the request.
4. The operator of any Golf Cart driven on any public highway within the Village of Canwood shall obey the general "Rules of the Road" such as, but not limited to, obeying traffic signs and/or lights, the use of turning hand signals, driving on the right hand side of the road, etc.
5. Under this bylaw Golf Carts will be exempt from compliance with the "Vehicle Equipment Regulations" as amended from time to time.
6. all persons operating Golf Carts on streets within the Village of Canwood shall save the Village harmless from all liability actions resulting from the operation of the Golf Cart.
7. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this Bylaw shall be subject to the penalties set out in the Village General Penalty Bylaw.
8. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon approval thereof by the Highway Traffic Board.
