2016 Census

Statistics Canada conducts a census every five years. The next census will occur this May 2016. It is very important that residents complete their mandatory form as it allows for the collection of demographic information. This information is then utilized by governments, businesses and community organizations to assist in making decisions with respect to our community when planning for services such as schools, housing, health care, police and fire services.

It is crucial that everyone is accounted for as population estimates from our census are used to allocate transfer payments from both the federal and provincial governments to our municipality.

Clean-up Day

The Village of Canwood will be once again having a "Clean-Up" day where we will pick up any items you wish to have hauled to the landfill. Items can be such things as old furniture, metal, wood scraps, old appliances and other items you may have that are not regular household garbage.

The Village will also continue with the twist of a "Swap" day, as one person's junk is another person's treasure. Tuesday, May 24, 2016, will be the swap day and anything that is placed on your curb that day is free for anyone else to pick up as their treasure. After lunch on the Wednesday, May 25, 2016, the remaining items will be picked-up and taken to the landfill.

This will be a FREE event for the residents of the Village with the exception of tires (fee will be based on size) and refrigerators or large appliances (\$25.00 freon disposal fee). If you require assistance with these larger items, please contact that Village office.

Please place all items for clean-up/swap at your front curb by 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, May 24.

Pick-up of items will begin on Wednesday, May 25 and continue on Thursday if needed.

Watering Policy

A reminder to residents that the Village of Canwood has the following watering policy in place:

“That the Council for the Village of Canwood sets the following policy on watering for lawns, gardens, flowers etc. The policy assumes the middle of Main Street as the divide line. The East portion of town from Main Street and South Avenue will be allowed to water on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. The West portion of town from Main Street and 1st Street West (across the tracks) will be allowed to water on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays. **No one will be allowed to water on Sundays.**”
