## Lawn and Garden Watering Policy

Council would like to recognize and extend a thank you to residents as the water consumption levels have dropped. We would still like to conserve water, but understand the need for watering lawns, gardens and flowers. As such, Council would like to gradually restore our watering policy with the following effective June 29, 2017:

### The policy assumes the middle of Main Street as the divide line

- The East portion of town from Main Street and South Avenue will be allowed to water on Mondays and Fridays.
- The West portion of town from Main Street and 1st Street West (across the tracks) will be allowed to water on Tuesdays and Saturdays.
- **No one** will be allowed to water on Wednesdays, Thursdays and Sundays.

We will likely be returning to our former watering policy once our malfunctioning well pump has been replaced. Please watch for the notices at local businesses within the Village. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the office or any member of Council.
