Watering Policy

A reminder to residents that the Village of Canwood does have the following watering policy in place:

“That the Council for the Village of Canwood sets the following policy on watering for lawns, gardens, flowers etc. The policy assumes the middle of Main Street as the divide line. The East portion of town from Main Street and South Avenue will be allowed to water on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. The West portion of town from Main Street and 1st Street West (across the tracks) will be allowed to water on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays. No one will be allowed to water on Sundays.”
